I. Theme Forum

Organized by: International Office, SSPU

Participants: global partners, SSPU teachers and students, and other representatives

What to do:

1. Global partners may give a report on the theme of Global Partnership Week 2026 — ***Intelligent Future: Industry-University-Research Integration and Talent Development in the AI Era.***
2. The participants exchange views on the theme of Global Partnership Week 2026.

II. Academic Salon

Organized by: schools of SSPU

Participants: global partners, SSPU teachers and students, and other representatives

What to do:

1. Academic seminar focusing on ***Path and Exploration of AI Empowerment for Industry - University - Research Integration*** will be organized by the School of Computer and Information Engineering to create the opportunity to have academic exchanges among the global partners and SSPU teachers and students in the similar fields.
2. Global partners may give an academic lecture or a lesson to SSPU teachers and students of relevant schools and majors.
3. Lab visit in relevant schools

III. Partnership Development

Organized by: schools of SSPU

Participants: global partners, SSPU teachers and students of relevant schools and majors, and other representatives

What to do:

Global partners will have communication with targeted SSPU teachers and students of relevant schools and majors based on our existing or potential cooperation.

1. We can organize a presentation or meeting for you with our students. You can introduce your university/institution and your exchange programs to the students. You can also interview the students who want to study at your university/institution. If you want us to arrange this activity, please tell us your requirements, such as the students you want to meet (major, grade, etc.).
2. You can meet with the heads and faculty of SSPU relevant schools to discuss about your cooperation.

IV. Study Abroad Fair

Organized by: International Office, SSPU

Participants: global partners, SSPU teachers and students

What to do: At the study abroad fair, each participating institution will have a booth. Global partners can communicate with SSPU students who are interested in their institutions and their student exchange programs.

V. Chinese Cultural Experience

Organized by: International Office, SSPU

Participants: global partners; SSPU international students; teachers and other students of SSPU

What to do:

1. Chinese cultural experience
2. Global partners, SSPU international students and other participants can display the traditional cultures and custom of their countries (regions). If possible, you may bring and share some traditional handicrafts, costumes, local food, etc. during the activity.
3. Performances with distinctive national characteristics, such as singing, dancing, etc.
4. Cultural interaction, such as playing traditional games of your countries (regions), etc.
